## **FIRST RECONCILIATION AND COMMUNION 2024 IN OUR PARISHES.**



The Sacrament of Eucharist is celebrated along with the Sacrament of Reconciliation for 2nd graders and older. After two years of faithful attending their formation classes (known as religious education) the Candidates for 1<sup>st</sup> Confession and 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist are allowed to receive these Sacraments. First Communion celebration in the parish is also a good reminder for the parents that they should go to Confession too, provided they are married by the Church.

So, question #1: **What is confession?** Confession is the telling of all of our sins to a priest to have them forgiven.

#2: **What is the Sacrament of Penance?** Penance is

a sacrament in which the priest, in the name of Jesus, forgives us our sins committed after Baptism.

#3: **When do we commit sin?** We commit sin when we knowingly and willfully trespass the commandments.

#4: **When do we commit a mortal sin?** We commit a mortal sin when we knowingly and willfully trespass Commandments in an important matter.

#5: **When do we commit a venial sin?** We commit a venial sin when we trespass commandments in a less important matter or not quite willfully.

#6: **What is the Most Blessed Sacrament?** The Most Blessed Sacrament is the true Body and true Blood of Jesus Christ under the appearances of bread and wine.

#7: **What is Holy Communion?** Holy Communion is receiving of Jesus under the appearance of bread and wine.

#8: **Who can receive Holy Communion?** Holy Communion can be received by everyone who does not have mortal sin.

***First Communicants will receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Saturday, May 4, and then there will be a Rehearsal for First Communion, and lunch (9:30 am to 2:00 pm)***

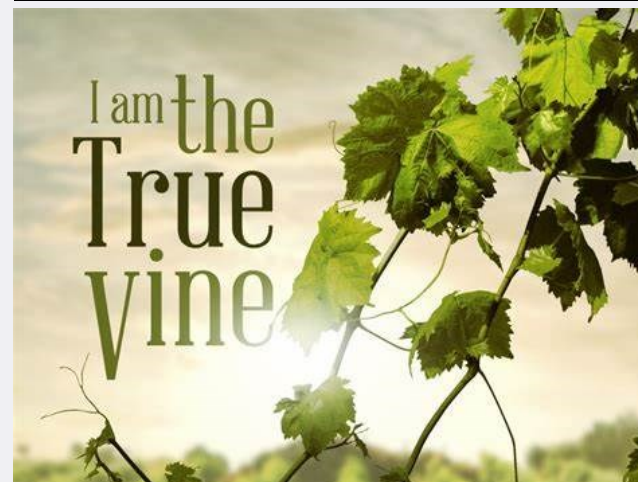
