### WORLD YOUTH DAY— LISBON 2023.



Former president of Portugal Aníbal Cavaco Silva expressed his concern for the younger generations, considering that World Youth Day is an opportunity to pay attention to young people's current quality of life. "St John Paul II instituted World Youth Days in 1985 saying that 'the Church must look to young people as its hope'," he said, stressing that the 15 editions of Youth Days have drawn crowds, "not just to see the Pope, but to celebrate the Hope that John Paul II evoked". In his opinion, "it is an honor for any country to host World Youth Day (WYD), and Portugal will rise to the enormous challenge". When WYD was created in 1985, the young people of the time, now "mature adults and many of them already grandparents", had better living conditions than their parents and grandparents. <https://amanalliance.org/data/newsDetails.php?id=66460>

**During World Youth Days (WYD) there are TWO PARTS** in which the young pilgrims are involved. The first part is called the **Days in the Dioceses:** This is a gathering of young people from all over the world before meeting the Pope, that is held from 26<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2023, and takes place in different dioceses, but not in the Diocese of Lisbon. <https://www.lisboa2023.org/en>

The second part is known as the **Days with the Pope.** For this the WYD Pilgrims must relocate from the dioceses, where they were busy with charitable, cultural, and religious activities, to the Diocese of Lisbon. The Holy Father will be there from 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> of August 2023.
