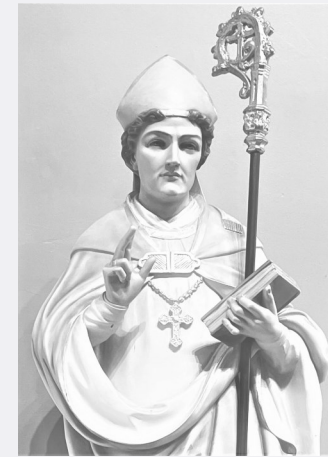
A box will be placed in the narthex of our church starting next weekend to collect Rosaries for this worthy purpose.
