DAY OF MOURNING for baby whose death was broadcast live on NPR

The pro-life movement is calling for Saturday, December 3rd to be a Day of Reparation, remembering the baby whose death by abortion on Nov.4 was broadcast live by National Public Radio, in an apparent effort by NPR to de-humanize the child in the womb, and to 'normalize' and 'mainstream' the idea that an abortion procedure is no different, really, than a trip to the dentist.

In the recording, one can hear the moans of the mother, but her child's scream is silent. When the killing was complete, the staffer tells the mom 'You did it' and 'You did great'. There is no mention whatsoever of the baby who has just died a brutal death at 11 weeks. The baby's humanity is never acknowledged, even as an after-thought.

Pro-life leaders have named the child Baby Amanda Marie, in recognition of the fact of her humanity, which was deliberately snuffed-out before she was born. It is asked that every pro-life individual, organization and lawmaker mark the day (December 3) with fasting and special prayers. These actions can be done privately, but the more they are done in common, as a group, the better.

In an act of solidarity with this innocent child, we have to re-humanize what this abortion and this broadcast de-humanized. We have to make a big deal of what this broadcast trivialized.

The Day of Mourning will honor the baby and will also ask God for forgiveness for the legal abortion deaths of more than 63 million children in the U.S. since 1973. Prayers will also be offered for the mother who chose abortion, for the abortionist and staffers who participated in the act, and for the NPR employees who took part in the broadcast.
