The bilingual Mass will be followed by a program featuring Father Dave Pivonka, TOR, president of Franciscan University in Steubenville, Ohio, and the Dave Moore Band. There will be Eucharistic Adoration, live praise and worship music and much more. Several parishes will provide kolaches and egg rolls, and there will be breakfast tacos.

***75th Anniversary Year of Celebration for the
Diocese of Austin 1947 – 2022.***

In 1947, the Catholic leaders of the San Antonio, Galveston and Dallas Dioceses voted to surrender counties within their Ecclesiastical jurisdiction to create the Diocese of Austin. This move led to the raising of St. Mary Church in Austin to a Cathedral Church and the selection of Louis J. Reicher, the Prothonotary Apostolic and Chancellor of the Diocese of Galveston, as the first Bishop of the Austin Diocese.



With the founding of the new diocese, St. Mary Parish, the oldest Catholic church in Austin, was elevated to the status of cathedral. This magnificent building was completed in 1884. Other churches in the diocese were established as immigrants, bringing their religion with them, began settling the area in the 1800s. While many Catholics in the Diocese of Austin trace their religious heritage to Mexico and Spain, there are large numbers whose ancestry is Irish, German, Italian, French, Czech or Polish.

His successor, Bishop Vincent Harris, focused on attracting Mexican Americans to religious vocations and worked with social justice issues, all while the diocese ordained record numbers during his 14-year tenure. Bishop Harris retired, and on Feb. 26, 1986, Bishop John E. McCarthy, a native of Houston, was installed as the third bishop of Austin. During the 15 years that he led the diocese, there was tremendous growth.

On Jan 2, 2001, Bishop Gregory Aymond became the fourth bishop of Austin when Bishop McCarthy's request for retirement was granted by the Holy See. On March 8, 2010, Bishop Joe S. Vásquez was installed as the fifth bishop of Austin after serving as the auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston since 2002.

Today, the Catholic population of the diocese stands at roughly 700,000. About 225 priests currently serve in the diocese, along with more than 400 deacons and vowed religious and countless lay men and women.
