WYD LISBON 2023 – THE OPENING OF 37TH WORLD YOUTH DAYS IN PORTUGAL.



The Welcome of the Pope and young people from all over the world took place in Parque Eduardo VII August 4th. Manuel Clemente, Cardinal-Patriarch of Lisbon, then welcomed everyone and thanked the Holy Father and the Pilgrims. In fact, as Francis said, if "this Day is the high point of your pilgrimage, your life must be fully realized." Minutes after these words are spoken, a box appears on stage. Inside are several letters, which the young people read in turn, addressing the Holy Father with the concerns they have "at hand". They talked about the future, faith, and mental health. From the hands of these young people, the pile of letters went towards those of the Pope, through Sr. Lara Saavedra, in a gesture of surrender.There was also the entrance of the flags of the countries of the various young people present. The Pilgrim Cross and the Icon of Our Lady Salus Populi Romani, Symbols of WYD, then departed from the center of the Colina de Encontro, and ascended through the central corridors. As the Cross made its way to the altar. The Pope then spoke directly to the young people who, according to him, were called by their own name to be on Colina do Encontro on Thursday afternoon. "We are loved as we are, without makeup," he said. Each one of those present is, deep down, a face, a heart, more than a number: "you were called by your name," he said. In this sense, all people are called to be as they are. "The Church has room for everyone," he said, prompting the crowd to shout "everyone," each in his or her own language. "God loves us," they all said again. In fact, "God loves by surprise, it's not programmed," he said. The Holy Patrons of WYD Lisbon 2023 were also evoked, the Our Father was prayed, and the Holy Father gave the Final Blessing. On stage, the ceremony ended as it began, with the joy of the young people who danced energetically. In large letters that they brought to the stage, it read: "I Send You." "The



kingdom of God has come near to you," it read later. The Official Anthem of WYD Lisbon 2023 was sung in the international version and, in unison, the young people shouted with enthusiasm: "esta é a juventude do Papa!" ("this is the youth of the Pope").... On the morning of Friday, August 4th, Pope Francis was at the Forgiveness Park as part of the program of World Youth Day (WYD) Lisbon 2023, where he heard the confessions.
