**THE SIX TRUTHS TO BE KNOWN AND BELIEVED BY ALL**

- 1) There is one God who created, preserves, and governs all things.
- 2) God is a just Judge, who rewards the good and punishes the wicked.
- 3) In God there are three Persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.
- 4) The Second Person, Jesus Christ, became man and died on the cross to save us.
- 5) The soul of man is immortal.
- 6) Grace is necessary for salvation.

**THE FIVE PRECEPTS OF THE CHURCH (Minimum requirements of a baptized Catholic)**

- 1) To attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days of obligation.
- 2) To fast and abstain on the days appointed (no dancing at forbidden times).
- 3) To confess one's sins at least once a year.
- 4) To receive Holy Communion during the Easter time.
- 5) To contribute (tithe) to the support of the Church.

- 3) The reverence we give to saints and angels as the servants and friends of God (**Dulia**)

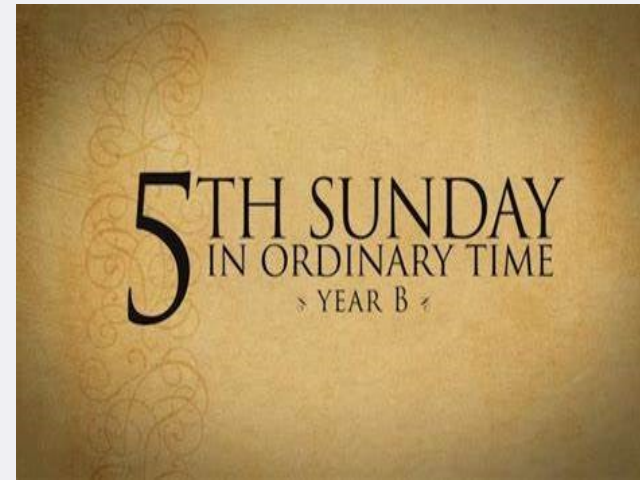
