ULMA FAMILY BEATIFICATION SEPTEMBER 10TH, 2023

Let us remember that when we talk about Ulma Family, we are not talking only about their heroic death, but also about their beautiful life and a beautiful testimony of openness to life and cooperation with other residents of Markowa - said Dr. Mateusz Szpytma a relative of Wiktoria Ulma in an interview with KAI agency.

Józef Ulma was born in 1900 in Markowa. His wife Wiktoria was 12 years younger. They got married on July 7, 1935. The following year, the first child was born - Stasia, who was preparing for her first Holy Communion at the time of her death. Then Basia, Władzio, Franuś, Antoś and Marysia were born. The Ulma house was a place of family meetings. Everyone who needed anything came to him. The photos taken by Józef show that it was a house full of love, kindness and warmth.

During the German occupation of Poland, the Ulma family hid eight Jews on their farm, for which they were murdered by the Germans on March 24, 1944. First, the Jews in hiding were killed, and then the whole family, including Wiktoria, who was heavily pregnant, and their six children.

In 1995, Józef and Wiktoria Ulma were honored with the Righteous Among the Nations medal, and in 2010, President Lech Kaczyński posthumously awarded them the *Commander's Cross of the Order of Polonia Restituta*.

On September 17, 2022, Pope Francis confirmed the decree on the martyrdom of the Venerable Servants of God, thus enabling their beatification, to take place on September 10 in Markowa, Poland. Thus is the first case in the history of the Church when the whole family, including the unborn child, has been raised to the glory of the altars.

And the names of the Jewish victims are as follows: Saul Goldman and his four sons. Also two daughters of Chaim Goldman, and his granddaughter. Their names were: Lea Didner with her daughter of unknown name, and Genia (Gołda) Grünfeld. All eight of them were killed by the nazis, because they were Jews.
