Together we bring hope. Father Thaddeus just got a letter from our Bishop stating.....through your prayerful leadership and the generosity of your parishioners, your parish of **St. Stanislaus** has surpassed its CSA goal of \$5,500 and has raised \$8,642.

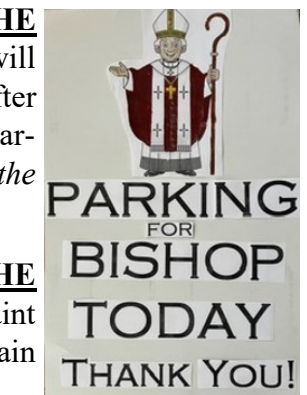
