
Catechetical Sunday—September 18, 2022

These words encapsulate so well the proposal which Jesus makes to each of us. He wishes to make a gift of himself, to give himself totally and without reservation to each of us. This is an invitation into a life of profound love, of mystery, and of deep challenge and adventure. The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. The term "Eucharist" originates from the Greek word eucharistia, meaning thanksgiving. In the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. The whole Christ is truly present -body, blood, soul, and divinity -- under the appearances of bread and wine, the glorified Christ who rose from the dead. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist.




